Through flood-relief funds that churches and individuals had given us, we were able to take food and supplies to people who are staying at a shelter because they can no longer live in or no longer have homes because of the two recent hurricanes and subsequent flooding. We were able to help a local church in that part of Honduras put on an event to provide the people with some of the things they lost in the floods and share the Gospel with them. From that night, four adults accepted Christ as their personal Savior!

We got the opportunity to travel with the church we are attending to other areas around and outside of the capital city to survey possible locations and ideas for church planting. There are so many communities that have the potential to sustain a national pastor and are in need of a healthy local church; please continue to pray for our efforts, that God would open the doors for a new church plant and national leadership soon, even amongst all these corona virus-related regulations and restrictions.
